The Somaliland UK Mission hosted a community engagement event in West London on Thursday, the 25th of October 2021. The aim of the event was to strengthen the unity of the Somaliland Community in the UK, to encourage community leaders, political party representatives, and other influential members to promote the case for Somaliland recognition, and to promote investment and business opportunities in The Republic of Somaliland.



The event was attended by the Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Relations, the Hon. DR Essa Kayd, and Somaliland's special envoy on Somaliland - Somalia talks, Dr. Edna Aden Ismail. Other dignitaries included British members of the parliament, Mayors, Consolers, and UK Business persons.

The Right Honourable Dr. Essa and Dr. Edna, delivered powerful and patriotic speeches that touched the hearts of everyone in re-affirming Somaliland's commitment to democracy, justice, equality, and peace and prosperity for its people and around the region of East Africa.

Other dignitaries including members of the British Parliament spoke of Somaliland's legitimate claim for full recognition while calling on the British Government to take the lead in recognizing Somaliland as a sovereign state.
